

Love your new magnet?

Want to keep it new?

Follow these guidelines to keep your magnet clean and safe!

- The area on the vehicle where the magnet is applied must be completely flat. Do not place the magnet over key holes, dips in the body design, side rails, runners, etc. Applying the magnet over these areas will allow air to get beneath the magnet and could cause it to come off while driving.
- A magnetic sign should never be applied to a newly painted vehicle. Allow at least 60 days for fresh paint to cure.
- Always make sure that the surface where the magnetic is to be applied is thoroughly cleaned. If small particles are left beneath the site of application they may cause the magnetic not to stick and therefore your magnetic could be lost.
- To clean the magnet sign, wipe gently with a damp, soapy sponge, but do not immerse the sign in water. Be sure to remove the magnetic sign before going through the car wash! Every so often remove the magnet and wash and wax beneath the area.
- When storing your magnetics do not roll up or fold. The magnets must remain flat to prevent any permanent curling, or creasing. Place your magnetic on any flat metal surface like a refrigerator or filing cabinet (note: do not put on/near a computer), Do not leave your sign inside your vehicle during warm weather. High temperatures can cause it to lose its aerodynamic properties.
